POLICY STATEMENT

This policy explains Denmark Technical College’s Student Conduct Hearing options. The conduct process aligns with the South Carolina Technical College System **Chapter 29-53-51 of the 1976 Code of Laws of South Carolina, As Amended**. It is the policy of the State Board for Technical and Comprehensive Education that the State Student Code and Grievance Procedure shall govern conduct and guarantee due process for students at the technical college. Students have the ability to waive the right to appeal sanctions levied in administrative hearing type.

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Purpose: To establish a policy to select student conduct hearing types.

Selecting Conduct Hearing Type:

Before proceeding to adjudication of conduct cases student(s) in the conduct process will be given the option of two hearing types: Administrative Hearing or Board Hearing

Administrative Hearing- by selecting an administrative hearing student are waiving their right to participate in a hearing by a board. The Dean of Students or designee will determine said student’s sanction. Selecting this hearing type means you waive your right to appeal your sanction. Thus, agreeing to accept the sanction.

Board Hearing - Board hearings are the College's formal process for determining if a student or student organization violated the Code of Student Conduct. Most cases are resolved through an informal resolution process, but a student may opt for a hearing instead. Hearing boards.

Hearing Board- Board hearings are the College's formal process for determining if a student or organization violated the Code of Student Conduct. Most cases are resolved through an informal resolution process, but a student may opt for a hearing instead. Hearing boards consist of at least 1 faculty, 1 staff, and 1 student. Sanctions determined by a hearing board are appealable.
