To receive free tuition, you must meet all of the following conditions:

- You must be at least 60 years of age.
- You must be a legal resident of South Carolina.
- You must not be employed full time.

Senior citizens must complete a FAFSA, and the senior citizen waiver will only be used to the extent tuition is not covered by other grant aid.

Senior citizens who qualify for financial aid and, thus, will not require a waiver may enroll in any program and register during regular registration.

Senior citizens who are requesting the waiver, do not complete a FAFSA, or do not qualify for any grant aid, must be coded as a career development student and may register beginning on the first day of class and up through the end of the add/drop period. The late registration fee will not apply in this situation.

The base tuition will be waived for credit classes only. Fees, books, supplies or miscellaneous expenses will not be covered by the waiver.

Completion of this form does not guarantee a seat in a class. Payment of the fee at the time of registration is the only way to guarantee a seat.

A senior citizen waiver can only be used one time per course.
